PRIVACY POLICY

This privacy policy has been compiled to better serve those who are concerned with how their ‘Personally identifiable information’ (PII) is being used online. PII, is information that can be used on its own or with other information to identify, contact, or locate a single person, or to identify an individual in context. Please read our privacy policy carefully to get a clear understanding of how we collect, use, protect or otherwise handle your Personally Identifiable Information in accordance with our websites.

What personal information do we collect from the people that visit our blog or websites?

When ordering or registering on our sites, as appropriate, you may be asked to enter your name, email address, phone number or other details to help you with your experience.

When do we collect information?

How do we use your information?

How do we protect visitor information?

Our websites are scanned on a regular basis for security holes and known vulnerabilities in order to make your visit to our site as safe as possible.

We use regular Malware Scanning.

Your personal information is only accessible by a limited number of persons who have special access rights to such systems, and are required to keep the information confidential. In addition, all sensitive/credit information you supply is encrypted via Secure Socket Layer (SSL) technology.

We implement a variety of security measures when a user places an order to maintain the safety of your personal information.

All transactions are processed through a gateway provider and are not stored or processed on our servers.

Do we use ‘cookies’?

Yes. Cookies are small files that a site or its service provider transfers to your computer’s hard drive through your Web browser (if you allow) that enables the site’s or service provider’s systems to recognize your browser and capture and remember certain information. For instance, we use cookies to help us remember and process the items in your shopping cart. They are also used to help us understand your preferences based on previous or current site activity, which enables us to provide you with improved services. We also use cookies to help us compile aggregate data about site traffic and site interaction so that we can offer better site experiences and tools in the future.

We use cookies to:

- Help remember and process the items in the shopping cart.
- Understand and save user’s preferences for future visits.

- Compile aggregate data about site traffic and site interactions in order to offer better site experiences and tools in the future. We may also use trusted third party services that track this information on our behalf.

You can choose to have your computer warn you each time a cookie is being sent, or you can choose to turn off all cookies. You do this through your browser (like Internet Explorer) settings. Each browser is a little different, so look at your browser's Help menu to learn the correct way to modify your cookies.

If you disable cookies off, some features will be disabled. It won't affect the users experience that make your site experience more efficient and some of our services will not function properly.

Username, Passwords, and Profiles

If prompted, Users must provide a valid email address to the Site, at which the User can receive messages. User must also update the Site if that email address changes. Rescheduling

With one-on-one sessions, rescheduling an appointment is possible with 24-hour advance notice. If you have an emergency, we'll work around it. Otherwise, missing an appointment without advance notice is considered a paid appointment.

With group sessions, missed sessions will not be compensated in any way or form.

Completion and cancellation

When it is time to end our coaching relationship, please provide 2 weeks' notice. I will then ensure no further charges will be made to your credit card, and we'll schedule a complimentary conclusion session. This gives us time to capture your learning and talk about for what is next in your life, as well as celebrate your successes.

Refunds

With individual programs: A full refund is available within 24 hours after the first coaching session.

With group programs: In case cancellation takes place *within the first 30 days*, refunds are available.
